Adding a Protocol

- Device Storage (offline)
 - Copy files from your computer to your tablet's SD card
 - Export results offline
- Gitlab
 - Use your own Gitlab repository to download protocols, export results
- (TabSINT Server)
 - Use a TabSINT specific server to download protocols and export results based on site names
- Information on tabsint.org



Protocol Requirements

- Directory with a protocol.json file at the top level
- protocol.json can reference media in the same directory
 - Images
 - Video
 - Audio
- Same for all methods



Adding via Device Storage



Gitlab

- Web service for managing file repositories
- Uses git version control system
- Create a unique repository for each protocol
- Add protocols to remote tablets in real time
- Gitlab help



Gitlab Credentials on TabSINT

• Host: host url of the gitlab instance

- https://gitlab.com/
- If you locally host your own gitlab instance, enter the root url used to access that instance (i.e. https://myowngitlab.com/)

• Token: secret key to access your repositories

- Generate personal token in gitlab
- Associated with username
- Grants access to any repository that username has access to
- Group: group name used to host your repositories
 - This will be your username if you have not set up any other groups.

Subprotocols

- Group sets of pages
- Define specific attributes on a subset of pages
 - Randomization
 - Constrain backwards navigation
 - Allow nesting protocols
 - Reuse sets of pages
